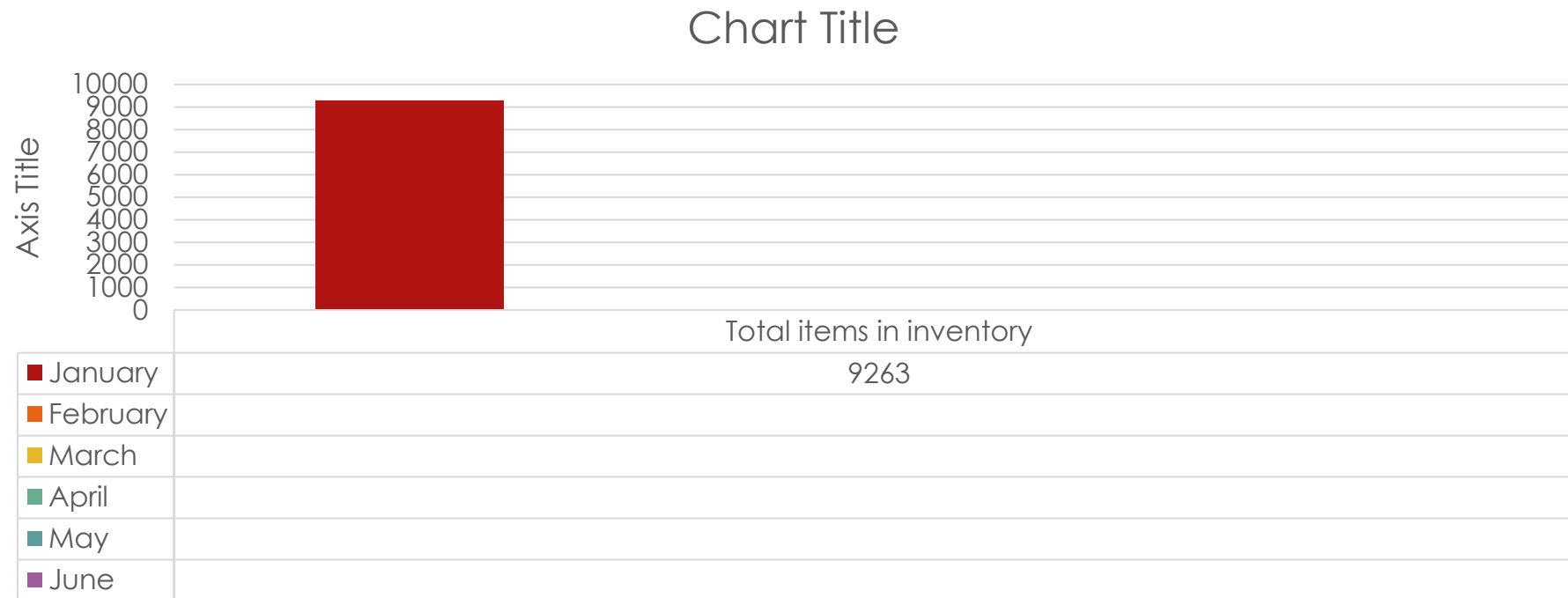

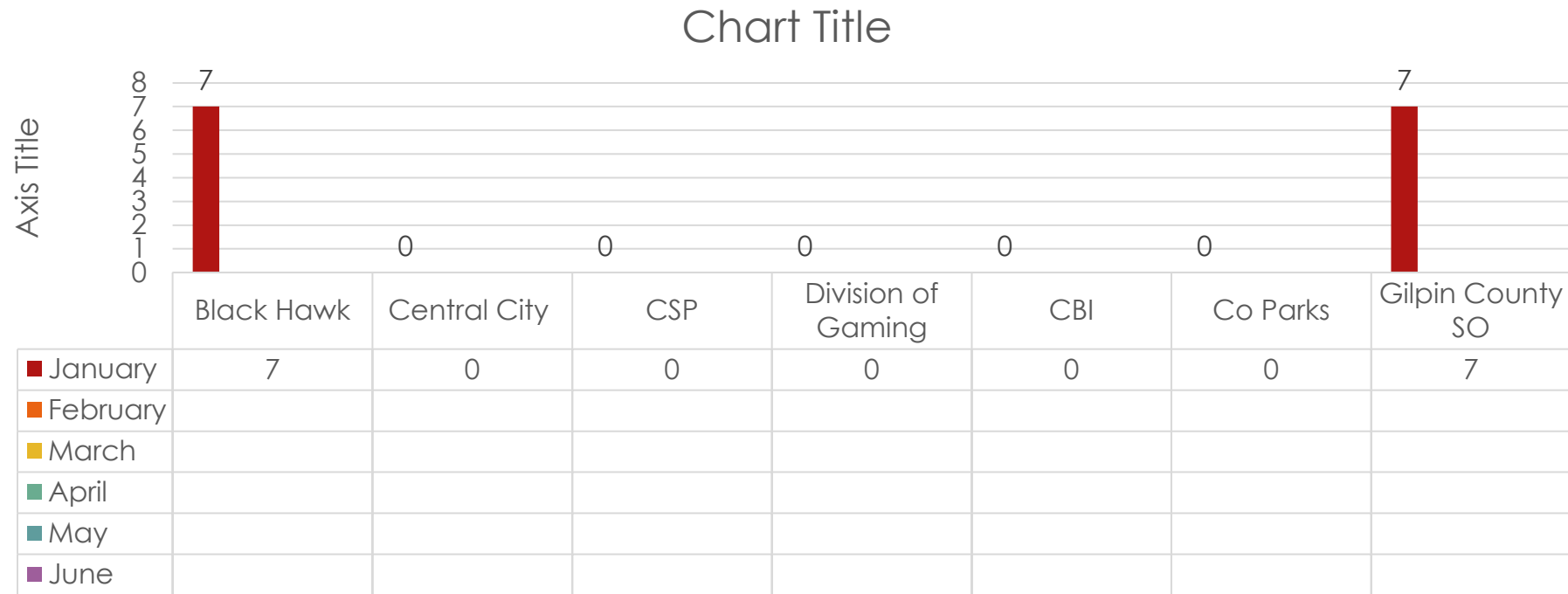

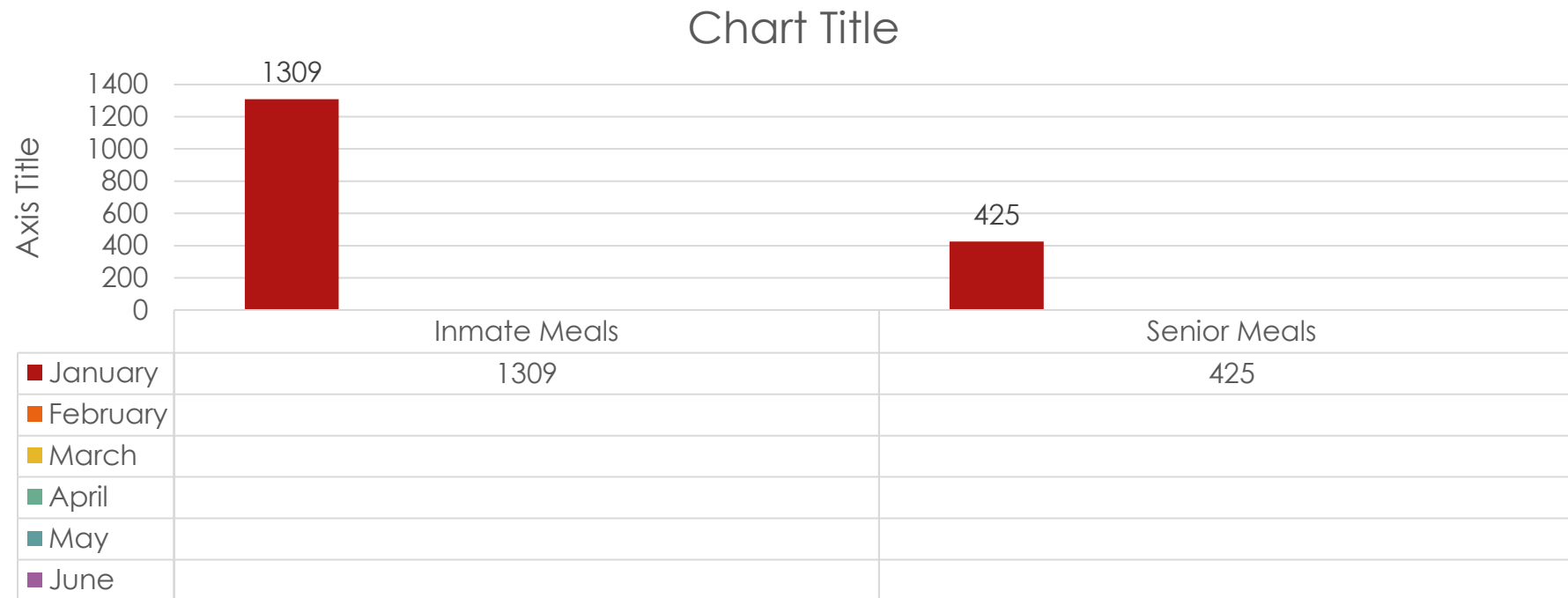




# Detentions Arrests by Agency



# Detentions (Meals)





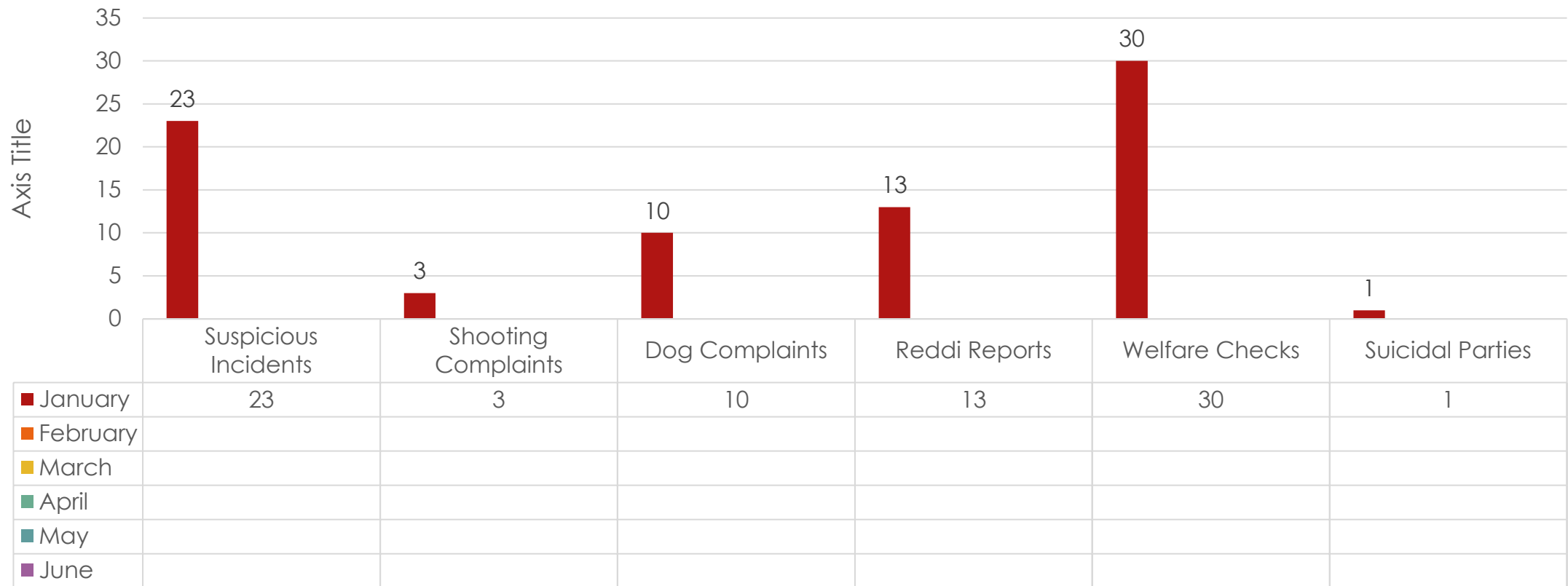

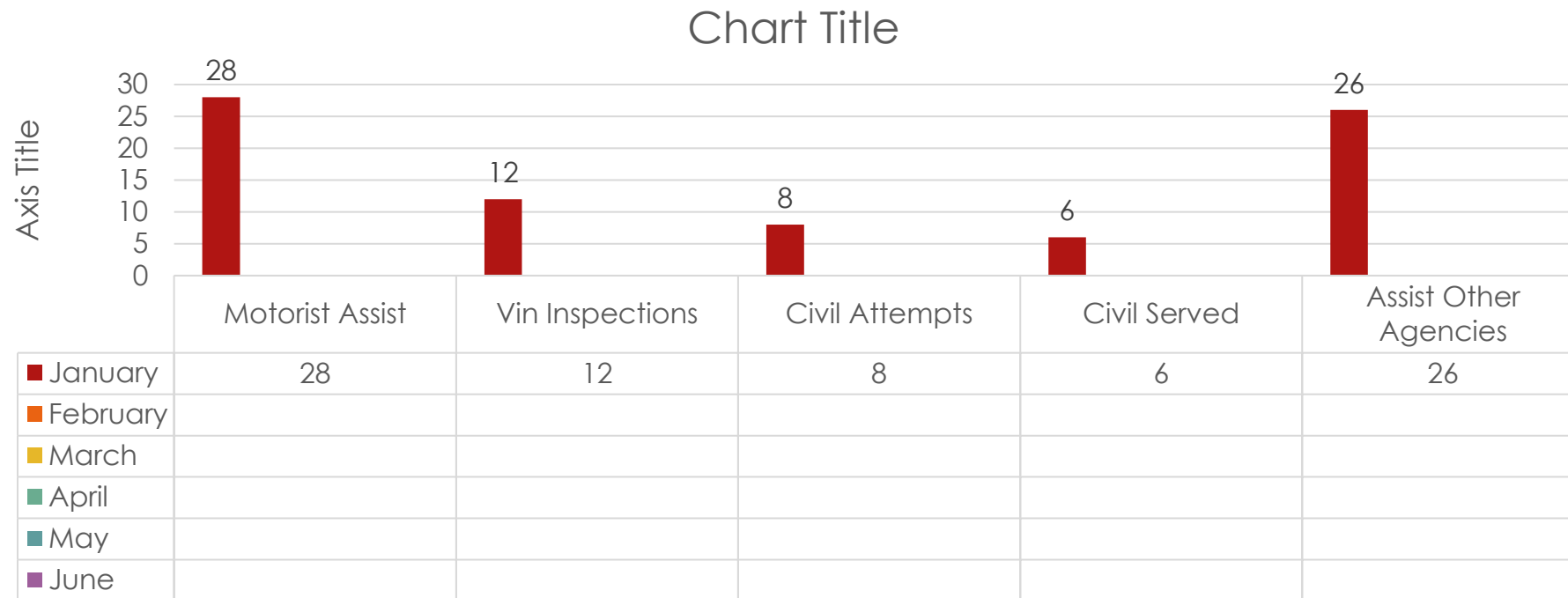

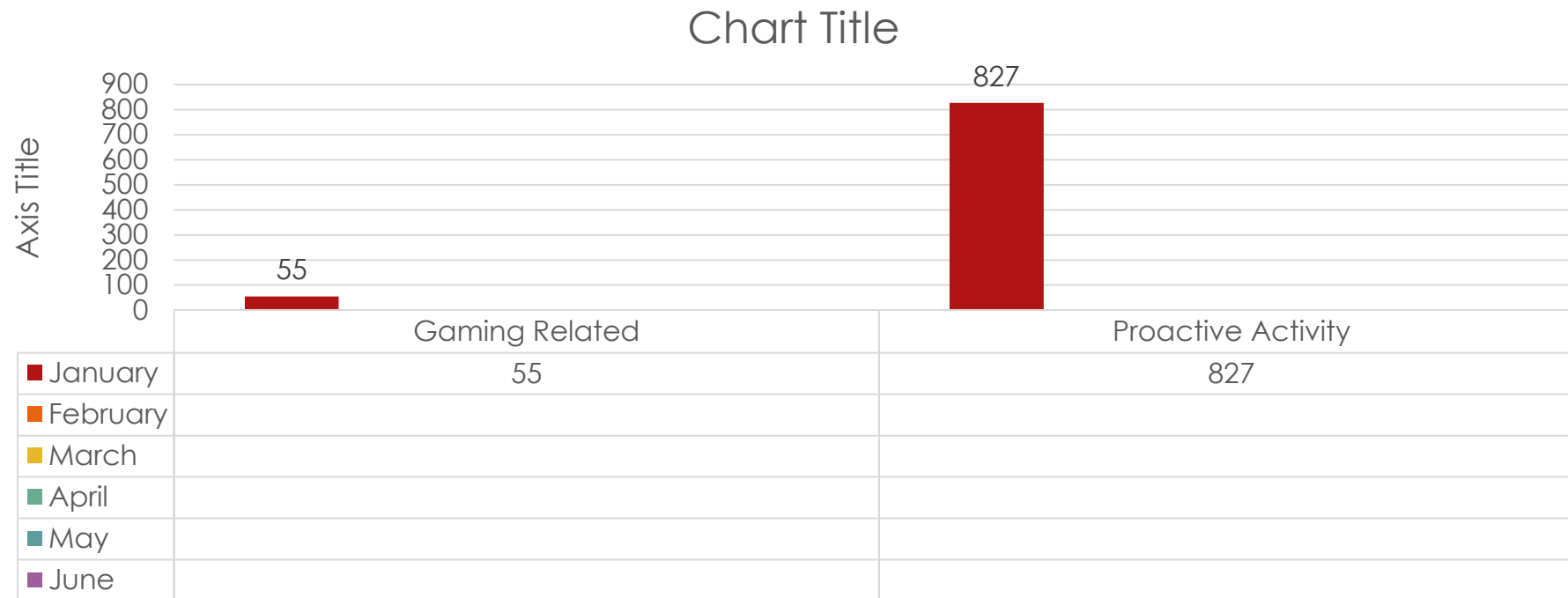

# Significant Events for January

- ▶ 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Assault (f): A male became involved in a verbal argument that escalated to an assault. The victim suffered a broken arm.
- ▶ Murder/Suicide Domestic Violence: A male and female were engaged in an argument. The male shot the female and then shot himself.
- ▶ 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Assault on EMT (f): Two males became involved in an argument. One male attempted to choke the other. The suspect left the residence and was found sleeping. He was being transported to the hospital due to his level of intoxication. During the trip to the hospital he assaulted the paramedic in the ambulance.
- ▶ Attempt Suicide: A deputy stopped to check on a vehicle on the side of the road. The deputy contacted the driver who was unresponsive. Several empty prescription bottles were found next to him. He was transported to hospital.

# Citizen Complements:

- ▶ Marie Romero for her professionalism and calm demeanor on the Murder/Suicide call
- ▶ Shandee Hartvigson received a call from a concerned party about her boyfriend. The boyfriend told his girlfriend that the fire alarm/Carbon Monoxide alarm kept going off even after he had reset it, that he was sleepy and had a headache. Dispatcher Hartvigson recognized that the man was in danger, dispatched resources to the address and called the boyfriend and had him get out of the house. According to firefighters on scene there was a fatal amount of carbon monoxide in the home. The boyfriend later called Dispatch and thanked them for saving him.
- ▶ Dispatch aired a CPR in progress call. It is my understanding that Deputy Bailey and Deputy G. Collins arrived and performed CPR. They were able to resuscitate the victim who was then transported to the hospital. Dispatcher Hartvigson was also instrumental in this incident.



# Citizen Complements: cont.

- ▶ Deputy G. Collins took a report for a suicidal subject. The information was not very helpful and a ping of the victim's phone narrowed the area to a 11-kilometer area near Hughesville Road and Highway 119. Undeterred, Deputy G. Collins continued to look for the suicidal subject. He found the victim in the 300 block of Dakota Ridge Road. The victim had run a hose from his exhaust into his car and sealed the car in an attempt to kill himself. Deputy G. Collins was not initially aware of what was wrong and found the victim unconscious. Deputy G. Collins called for paramedics and removed the victim from the car. Had Deputy G. Collins not been diligent in his search for the victim, had not acted quickly and decisively, I am certain the in his suicide attempt. Dispatcher Hartvigson was also instrumental in this incident. victim would have been successful
- ▶ Two citizens called in to thank the Sheriff's Office for the professional and courteous demeanor of on traffic stops. Deputy Sedlmayr and Deputy Collins.
- ▶ I received a letter from Sheriff Sauve in Marinette County SO in Wisconsin, thanking Investigator Jeff Collins for his assistance in a Child Pornography Case. Investigator Collins located the suspect, interviewed him and obtained a confession in assisting them with a case that had been active since 2017.

# Sheriff's Office Community Initiatives:

The OEM continues to work with Gilpin County Department of Health on the vaccination program. GCART is manning the phones to assist with the coordination.
