


# Detentions Average by year



# Detentions Arrests by Agency



# Significant Events for November

- ▶ 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Burglary: Roy's Last Shot – Unknown person forced entry into the restaurant/bar after closing. Several items were stolen and hundreds of dollars in damage was reported. Still under investigation
- ▶ False Reporting of Explosives: A party called saying he was going to blow up the Easy Street Casino. A through search of the premises found nothing suspicious.
- ▶ There has been an increase in break-in's into vehicles this month, mostly in the parking garages.
- ▶ Death Investigation: A females body was dumped off the side of the road on Hwy 72 about a mile east of Pinecliffe. The investigation is continuing with several leads being investigated.
