
Detentions Average by year




Detentions Arrests by Agency





Significant Events for November

- ▶ 2nd Degree Burglary: Roy's Last Shot Unknown person forced entry into the restaurant/bar after closing. Several items were stolen and hundreds of dollars in damage was reported. Still under investigation
- ► False Reporting of Explosives: A party called saying he was going to blow up the Easy Street Casino. A through search of the premises found nothing suspicious.
