
#### Detentions Average by year







- ▶ The Sheriff's Office saw an increase in OHV accidents in the month of June.
- Death Investigation: A females body was dumped off the side of the road on Hwy 72 about a mile east of Pinecliffe. The female had been at this location at least a week before being found. This is being investigated as a homicide.
- A Domestic Violence: A female was arrested for DV/2<sup>nd</sup> degree Arson. The male and female were involved in an argument. The female took a suit case of personal belonging of the male and set them on fire.
- There was lightening strike on the side of a mountain up from Cottonwood Creek at about mile marker 4 that started a fire. The fire was attacked by two helicopters and was extinguished quickly.
