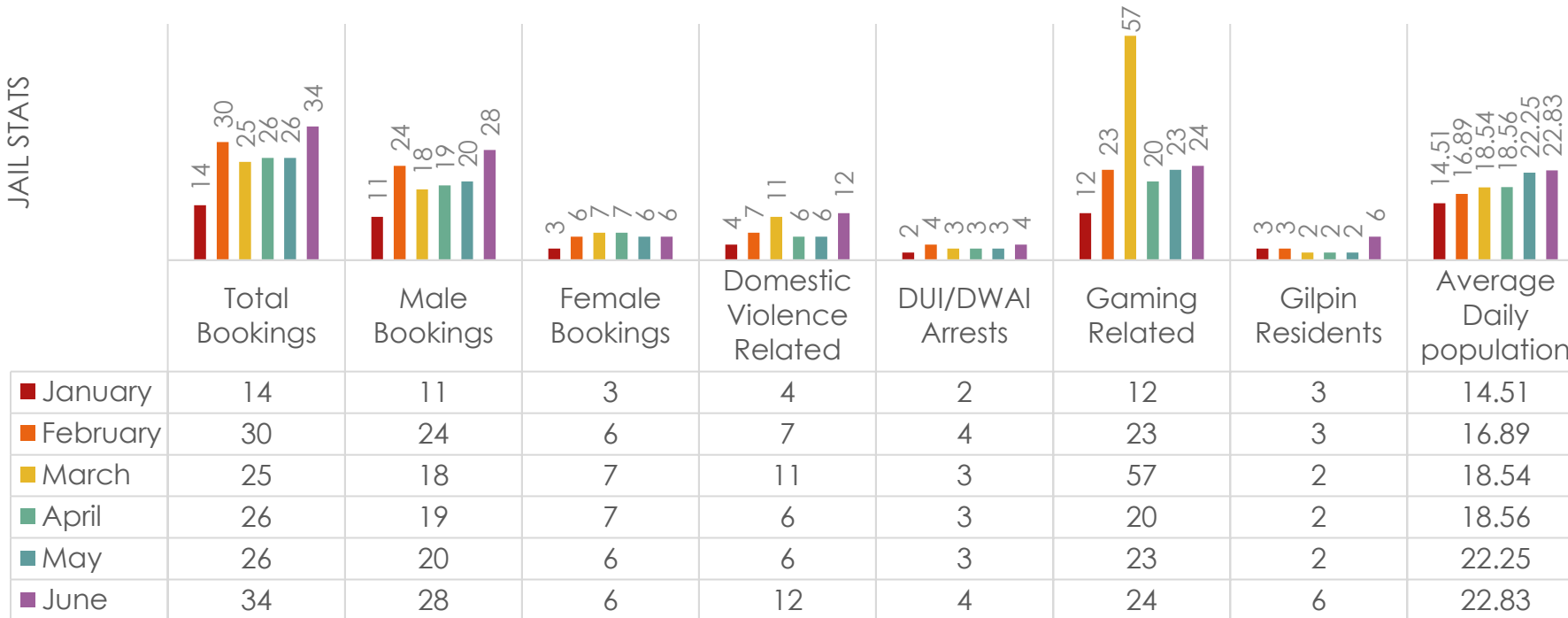

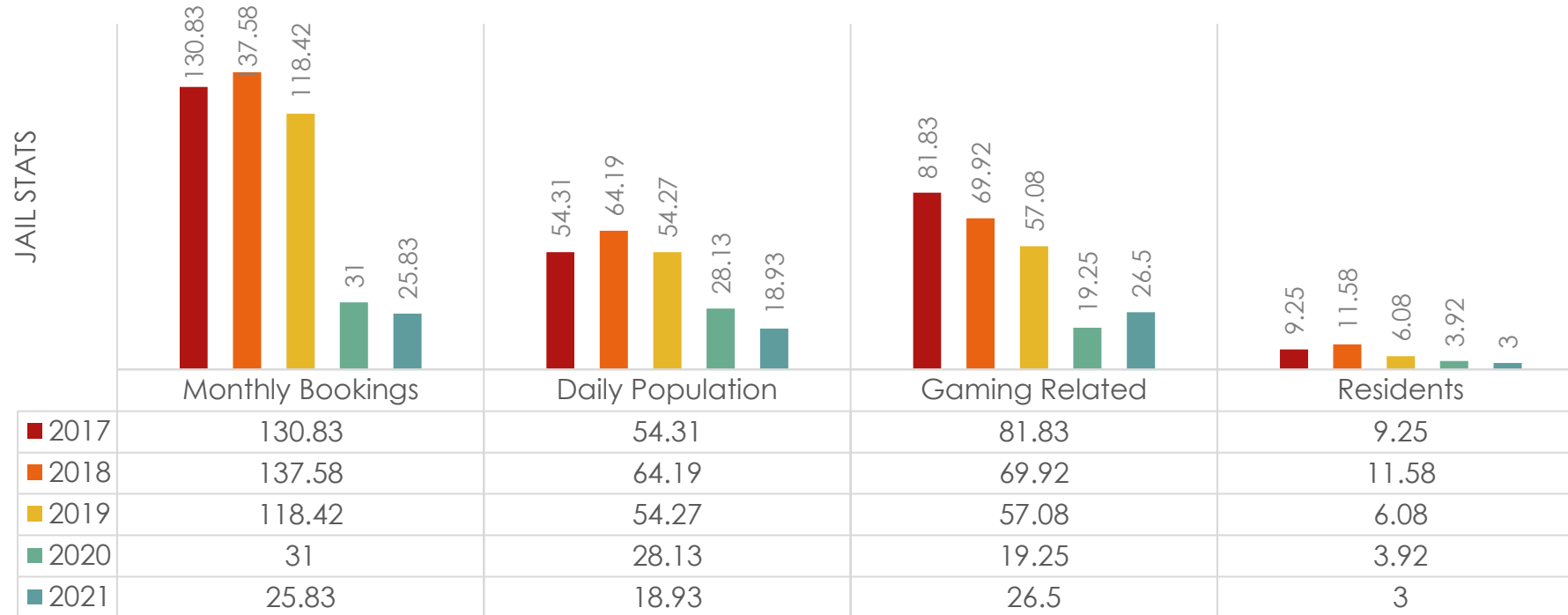

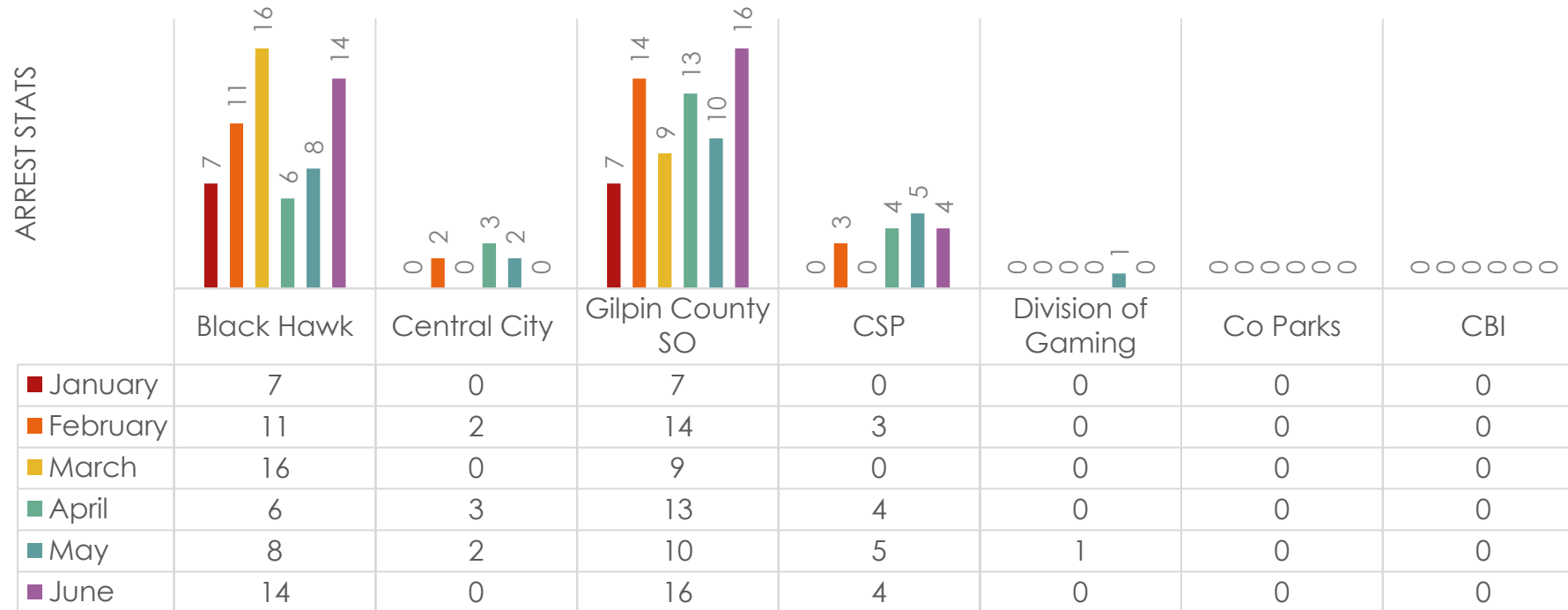




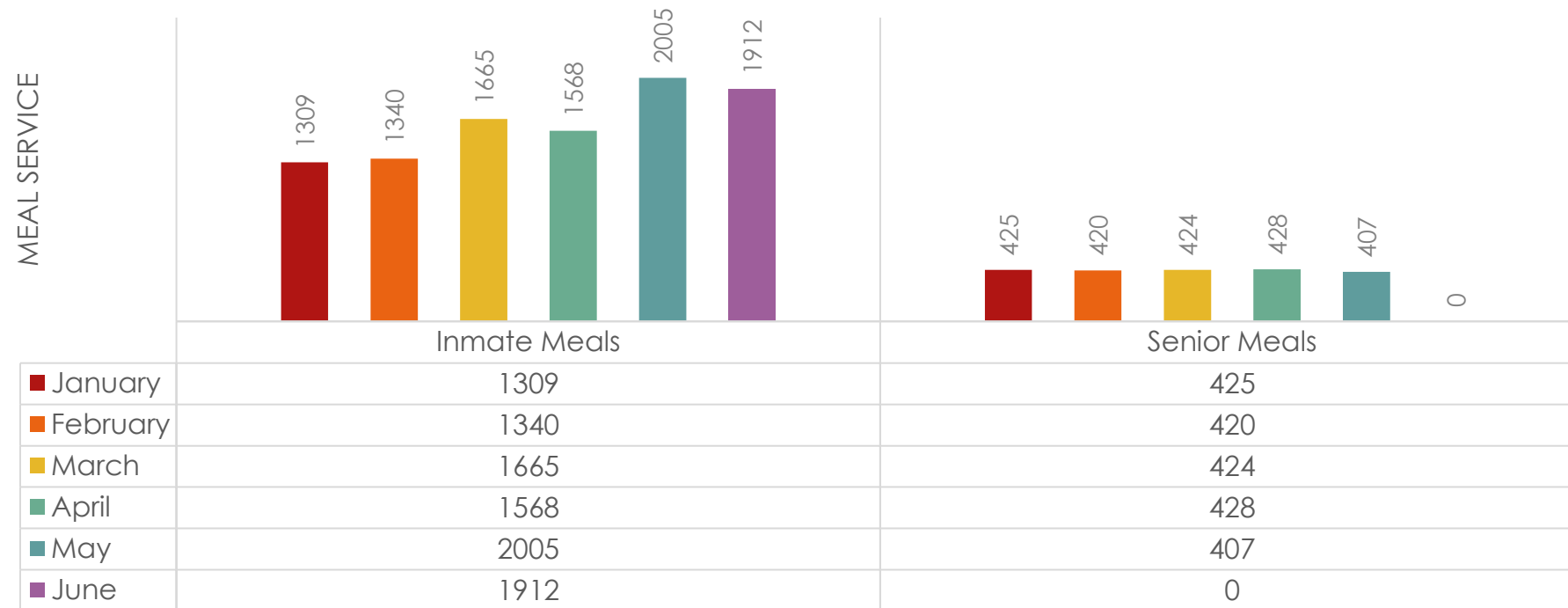
# Detentions Average by year



# Detentions Arrests by Agency

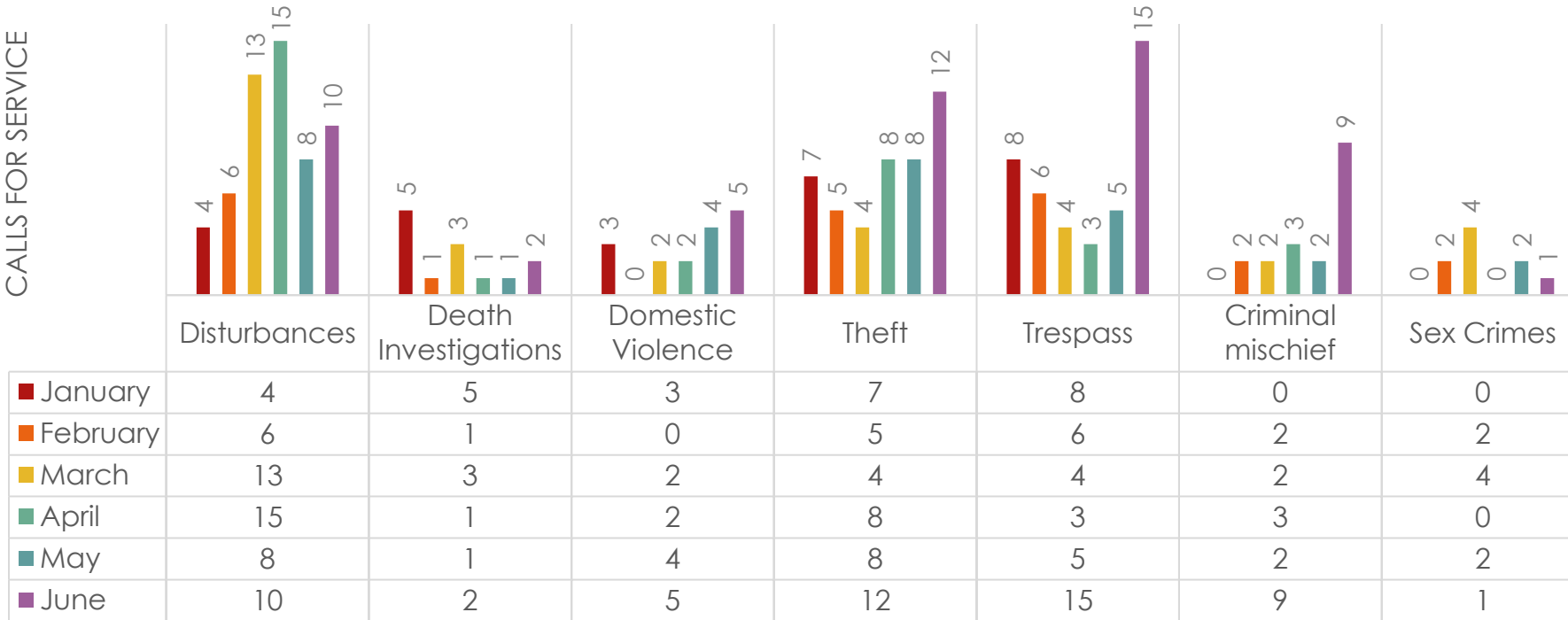

# Significant Events for May

- ▶ The Sheriff's Office saw an increase in OHV accidents in the month of June.
- ▶ Death Investigation: A female's body was dumped off the side of the road on Hwy 72 about a mile east of Pinecliffe. The female had been at this location at least a week before being found. This is being investigated as a homicide.
- ▶ A Domestic Violence: A female was arrested for DV/2<sup>nd</sup> degree Arson. The male and female were involved in an argument. The female took a suitcase of personal belongings of the male and set them on fire.
- ▶ There was a lightning strike on the side of a mountain up from Cottonwood Creek at about mile marker 4 that started a fire. The fire was attacked by two helicopters and was extinguished quickly.

- ▶ Communications Supervisor received an email from a citizen, complementing Shandee Hartvigson on her being an exceptional dispatcher. The citizen outlined her achievements during a very busy night.
