
Detentions Average by year




Detentions Arrests by Agency







Significant Events for February

- Assist to Black Hawk PD, report of a deceased female in one of the motel rooms. A male was seen removing items from the room and placing them in a car in the parking garage. Female had three large rocks of suspected "Purple Heroin".
- Significant drug cases last month: (We are seeing an increase in drug related cases this last month)
 - ▶ Black Hawk PD recovered 800 grams of meth with cut in one of the casinos. Est. street value of \$300,000.
 - Clear Creek SO and CSP stopped a car with 4 kilos of Cocaine and 2 Kilograms of Fentanyl.
 - CSP stopped another car in Clear Creek with 150 pounds of Meth and Fentanyl.

Significant Events for February

- ▶ Felony Menacing: A male and female were playing multiple slot machine. A male started and argument with the male and female for taking up to many slot machines. The second male then pulled a knife on the male and female. The second male was arrested.
- ► The Sheriff's Office is seeing an increase in auto thefts as well as recovered stolen autos in the county.
- A burglary at a resident (Unoccupied during the winter) was discovered by a neighbor. The residents had several car parts and vehicle fluids in the garage. The residents was being used as a chop shop for stolen vehicles; info a stripped Subaru was recovered 2 weeks prior within a mile of this residence.

Citizen Complements:

▶ Deputy Rak received a complement from a party he stopped for speeding. The party was preoccupied with the death of her daughter 2 weeks ago. She characterized Deputy Rak as compassionate, kind and took the extra time to talk to her and calm her down from all her emotions.

Sheriff's Office Community Initiatives:

The OEM continues to work with Gilpin County Department of Health on the vaccination program. GCART is manning the phones to assist with the coordination.

The Sheriff's Office in collaboration with Central City, Central City Fire, Black Hawk Fire and Timberline Fire on distributing free CO detectors to residents in Gilpin County. Colorado Natural Gas delivered 18 CO detectors.
